

EGSAC Meeting Minutes

Officer Reports:

1. President – Ryan Abernathey
 - Need to establish EGSAC budgets
 - Need to establish dates and organizers for Fall Potluck and EAPS Slideshow
2. Vice President – Erin Shea
 - Nothing to report
3. Sports Chair – Dan Chavas
 - Absent due to course conflict; Bowling is cancelled for the fall semester. The entire bowling league may be cancelled due to dwindling participation.
4. Treasurer – Grant Farmer
 - Discussion of budget (see below)

 - Will look into getting GSC funding (\$250 each) for EAPS events

Budget:

1. EAPS Student Seminar
 - PAOC will likely provide an additional \$2000 to help cover the student seminar, now that PAOC students are getting involved with it.
 - Grant thinks additional GGG funding may be available; looking into it.
2. Sports Budget
 - EGSAC is debating whether to institute a small sign-up fee (5-10 dollars) to play in intramural sports (to help offset participation costs or any fines incurred during the season). This will be dependent on how the final budget works out.
 - Since bowling has been cancelled for the fall, we will re-assess funding bowling in the spring if there is even a team for that semester.
3. GSC Funding
 - We may try to get GSC funding to support some of the ‘special’ Peer Hours, such as the Potluck or the Slideshow. Each rep could get \$250 for the year (total \$500).
4. General Budget Vote
 - EGSAC voted unanimously to support a preliminary ‘bare-bones’ budget proposed by Grant. These numbers may be adjusted as additional sources (such as GSC funding, etc.) are applied. This budget will be made available soon, as it is currently being finalized.
